# **How the Certification Program Works:**

To be eligible to become RAC-CT® Certified (Resident Assessment Coordinator-Certified®) an individual must:

- Be a clinician/professional involved in the RAI process.
- Complete 10 AANAC courses, seven of which are required as core curriculum (MDS Coding for OBRA and PPS, RUG-IV, OBRA Timing and Scheduling, CAAs, PPS Timing and Scheduling, Introduction to Medicare Part A, and Care Planning) and three electives which are (Accurately Assessing Functional Status, Five-Star Quality Rating System and Quality Measures and the MDS 3.0)

Certification is good for two years once all required courses are completed and passed. You have 90 days to pass each final exam from the date the exam is launched, upon successful completion, students will receive their RAC-CT® certificate.

# **Course Completion Requirements for CE**
